CALL TO ORDER:

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA:

The agenda was reviewed by the Town Board. Motion to amend the agenda to include Conditional Use Permits that were tabled from last month's meeting, that will continue to be on the agenda until action is made, was made by Don Davis. Seconded by Bob Carlson; Motion carried:

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES:

The January 9, 2022, meeting minutes were reviewed by the Town Board. Don Davis stated that there was an extra sentence under Fire and EMS that should be removed. Don Davis made a motion to amend and adopt the minutes. Seconded by Bob Carlson; Motion carried:

AUDIENCE COMMUNICATION:

Audience Communication was opened with RCSD deputy. There were concerns of shots being heard on St. Lawrence Road and Newark Road, speeding and trash being dumped. Don Davis gave a report on the WTA conference that he and Bob Carlson had attended in Whitewater.

Re: Renewal of Conditional Use Permits for 2023.

FIRE and EMS:

Kevin Kangas gave a summarized report of the Newark Advisory Fire and EMS Committee meeting that was held February 8, 2023.

Variance Request:

Joe Cash, 9019 S. County Road H, request a front set back variance for a pole building. Joe Cash was present. The site plan was reviewed by the Town Board. There was discussion heard regarding the removal of the old barn and the new pole barn being on the old foundation. The new pole barn will be larger than the barn removed. Motion to approve the variance was made by Bob Carlson. Seconded by Don Davis. Motion carried.

Carl Bauer, 6836 W. State Road 81, request a variance to build a new residence and live in home while under new construction. Carl and Cindy Bauer were present. Discussion was heard in regard to the lot line, the removal of the old home after the new home was complete and the need of a policy to insure the removal of the old home. The new home will use the existing septic and well. Motion to approve the variance was made by Bob Carlson. Seconded by Don Davis. Motion carried.

Jeff Tucker, 11220 S. Smythe School Road, request for a variance for an agricultural driveway. Jeff Tucker was present. The Board reviewed the site plan for the agriculture driveway. Don Davis made motion to approve the ag driveway stipulating that the size of the culvert meet the Town Ordinance requirements. Seconded by Bob Carlson. Motion carried.

Report / Actions for Parcel 6-14-242:

Don Davis had received a call in regard to the driveway and new electrical poles being on this parcel of land. The County and Chris Murphy have been notified and several emails have been exchanged. Don will keep the Town informed.
